

### **Directions to Heckscher Museum of Art**

By Car from the East or West: Long Island Expressway, Northern State or Southern State Parkways to Route 110 North. Right turn onto Route 25A East, Main Street in Huntington. Left at next traffic light onto Prime Avenue. Museum is in Heckscher Park on the right.


By Bus: Take the H6 or H9 HART bus to the corner of Prime Avenue and 25A, or the SI Suffolk Transit bus to the corner of Prime Avenue and New York Avenue.

By Train: Take the L.I.R.R. to Huntington Station. The Museum is five minutes away by taxi.

### **Directions to The Bryant Library**

Bryant Library is located at 2 Paper Mill Road in Roslyn. Exit Rt. 25A at east end of Roslyn viaduct: turn left at light onto Bryant Avenue: bear left at the fork onto East Broadway until intersection with Paper Mill Road.

Open weekdays 9 am to 9 pm (Wed. from 10 am to 9 pm), Sat. from 9 am to 5 pm and Sun. from 1 pm to 5 pm. Because of scheduled programs in the gallery/meeting room, call 516-621-2240 to confirm availability for viewing.
