

INTRODUCTION

The Heckscher Museum of Art is at the brink of a remarkable transformation that will restore and expand our classic 1920 Beaux Art building. As we look toward a bright future, our 85th anniversary exhibition, A Century of Collecting, honors our past and present and pays tribute to the many collectors and donors whose generosity has made our collection so exceptional. Hung salon style throughout the Museum, treasures range from Old Masters to contemporary, reflecting the depth and breadth of a collection that has now grown to more than 2,000 objects. Art collected by founder August Heckscher a century ago — on view here when the museum opened its doors in 1920 — is complemented by objects acquired over the eighty-five years since. In lieu of a traditional chronological installation, the exhibition is hung in groupings that span centuries, media, nationality and style.

Gallery 1 focuses on the figure, ranging from one of the oldest traditions in art, the nude, to a section titled *The Human Condition*. In it, artists examine aspects of our lives from childhood to old age, from the warmth of family to the loneliness of a crowd, from the pairing of lovers to the pairing of child and parent. A special section features Museum founder August Heckscher surrounded by portraits and self-portraits of artists.

In **Gallery 2,** *Structure* is devoted to architectural form, pairing windmills and lighthouses with images of urban towers – and an entire wall featuring arcades.

Pastimes features images of leisure activity and relaxation. Still Life explores a timeless theme ranging from meticulous 19th-century oils to modern masterpieces. Finally, Color and Light encompasses luminal and glass sculpture, extraordinary 19th and 20th-century landscapes and vibrant color abstractions.

Our **Lobby Gallery** features scenes of Italy, a fitting tribute to our founder August Heckscher, since an entire gallery in the historic Heckscher Museum was devoted to Venetian themes.


In Gallery 3, we focus on scenes of land and sea, of vistas close to home as well as far away. We begin with scenes of Long Island. In *American Paradise* we move up the Hudson River to the roots of American landscape, with works from the original August Heckscher gift and the Baker/Pisano Collection.

With *Westward*, we look to the Grand Canyon and beyond. *By the Sea* returns to a nautical theme, but dances between centuries and nations. Our broadly international theme continues in *Travelogue*, featuring vistas from the Caribbean, Egypt and Europe. Alluring French scenery dominates in *Pastorale*.

In Gallery 4, we combine two themes. *Horsefeathers*, a light-hearted look at animals in art, demonstrates that artists have approached our best friends employing styles, modes and media as varied as human portraiture over the years. *Line, Gesture, Motion*, examines the manner in which the formal elements of composition – line, form, gesture and color – contribute meaning to art, both abstract and representational.
